The Superintendent introduced Sandy Pond, Principal and Nancy Griffiths-Zayner, Teacher of Charles Hays Secondary School. The district participated in a Provincial Assessment of Literacy video project, to demonstrate assessment methods used in the district.

Ongoing assessment is critical to the implementation of the new curriculum, benefiting both students and teachers. The challenge of learning French in a culturally appropriate way lends itself to this ongoing assessment process.

Students need to be active participants in the design and implementation of assessment. This allows them to take control of their learning.

Learning from failure (tolerance of failure) is an objective of assessment – it is a way to learn how to do things better.

Building relationships with students puts their work and effort into perspective.
