3. Superintendent Report

3.1 COVID Update

The Superintendent updated the Board on the new mask mandate for the K-12 sector. The Ministry of Education has not yet issued their updated guidelines. The district has provided masks to all elementary schools and is ordering more child masks. Plastic barriers are still available.

As Northern Health was not able to attend the meeting, other questions can be forwarded to staff who will seek answers from Northern Health.

The Board has no medical expertise, so it is important to rely on public health and Ministry guidance. The district does go beyond recommendations in some ways, but can't do things that public health indicates could increase risk of infection.
