Framework for Enhancing Student Learning

The Director of Instruction, Sandy Pond, presented on the Framework for Enhancing Student Learning.

The FESL presentation was put together to illuminate the Provincial Framework for Enhancing Student Learning. This framework is a shared commitment to improve student success and to improve the equity of student outcomes with a particular focus on Indigenous students, children and youth in care and students with disabilities and diverse abilities. The School District works through an annual cycle of consultation, collaboration and communications. The Strategic Plan developed by the Board is foundational and learning, budgets and operations all align with this document and our priorities of Equity, Truth and Reconciliation, and Mental Health Literacy. We collect different types of assessment data throughout the year to monitor improvement and student success. The Framework Survey is one piece of data we collect and this is also a way to hear our students' voices. School District data can be accessed in a number of ways as follows;
